MUNICIPAL BOARDS: There are vacancies on the Cemetery, Carbon County Visitors Council and the Carbon County Economic Development Boards. These are Boards that can help effect the future of our community and county. If you are interested please contact the Town Office.

CONSENSUS FUNDING: The Carbon County Consensus Funding has been approved and the Town will be purchasing a new refuse truck. After SLIB approves the bid and the order is placed it should be an estimated 180 days before delivery.

RATE INCREASES FOR TRASH AND LANDFILL: The amended rate increase ordinance passed on 3rd reading. The rate increase will begin on the December utility billing.

COMMUNITY CENTER PROJECT: The Wyoming Business Council Feasibility Planning Grant is complete and has been submitted for approval. If the Town receives this study grant it will help to identify any environmental issues with the existing property and buildings. It will also help to see what the community can afford to build with the help of other grants and what can be expected for operation and maintenance costs. When various plans and numbers are in place the Council will hold public meetings for the communities input.

COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT: Wyoming Rural Development is waiting on one more report before issuing the assessment results. It will be available online at their website when complete. The major themes that came out of the assessment were:

Infrastructure-New bridge, roads, flood control & natural gas

Community Development-Multi-Purpose Center, library expansion, beautification & trail system

Economic Development-New businesses & improved internet

Communication-Education & community networking

FIRE DEPARTMENT: The Fire Department will be holding their Annual Chili Cook-off Dec. 15th at the Fire Hall. Caroling will start at 5:00pm with the Cook-off at 6:00pm. A raffle for the quilt and silent auction will also be held. Chief Sherwood says there are some great donations for the auction so come out and support our volunteer fire department.
