**PARK BOARD:** The Park Board had their last meeting of the season in October. They plan on starting next spring with the landscape project at the park in front of the pavilion. The project includes a sprinkler system, sod, pavers and new plantings. If you are interested in getting the ice rink set up volunteers are needed.

**MUSEUM BOARD:** During the winter the Museum can be visited by calling the numbers posted on the museum door.

**SENIOR CENTER:** The Seniors enjoyed their Annual Christmas Party with food, games and white elephant gifts. Lunch served daily and special breakfasts throughout the month; come enjoy dinner "as a senior or with the seniors" just call ahead if you'd like to attend.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL:** The Mayor would like anyone interested in serving on the EDC Board to let him know or stop by the Town Hall to express your interest.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT:** The department hosted their Annual Christmas Caroling and Chili Cook-off. Over 75 people attended and the department raised over \$1,450.00. Chili-Cook-off Award winners were Tammy Martinez, the People's Choice, Bob O'Connor, the Red Chili and Tammy Page, the Green Chili. Cathy Williams donated her 15<sup>th</sup> 9/11 memorial quilt for the raffle. Betty Richardson was the lucky person to take the quilt home.

**COMMUNITY CENTER PROJECT:** The Community Center Project is under way. The Town took ownership of the current library building from the County. Conceptual drawing and cost estimates are in for the renovation of the Public Works Building to the new County Library space. Reed Brannon is working with potential donors to help fund the renovation. Research into what will be done with the old building is in discussion. WWC Engineering out of Laramie is working on the plans for the new Public Works building that will be located behind the cold storage building on Veterans Street. The Request for Proposals is being advertised. Funding for this phase of the project is being provided by the Carbon County Consensus Grant.

**BROS-MEDICINE BOW RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT:** With the winter weather we have had over the last couple of week the contractors has decided to suspend the project for a few weeks to wait for some more conducive weather following the new year according to Jake Lonn, WyDot Resident Engineer. The Bridge has been removed and original trusses have been set on Mill Creek near the cemetery. The town's water and sewer is approximately 75% done. All of the drilled shafts are completed and the contractor began placing reinforcing steel for the west abutment, but are not able to pour concrete for this abutment with the current weather conditions. The contractors have currently started clean up for the holiday shutdown. A protective fence will be place around the project area and concrete barriers have been placed to protect traffic from the steep slopes and excavations. The detour has been removed through town for the holiday season. Weather dependant the contractor is planning on returning in 3 to 6 weeks. When work starts again they will have community meetings to present schedules and upcoming work plans.
